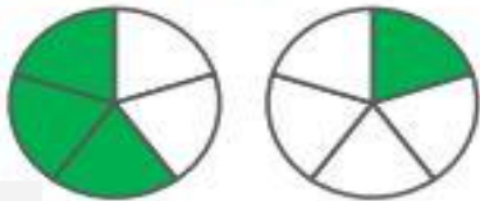


Add and Subtract Fractions

False

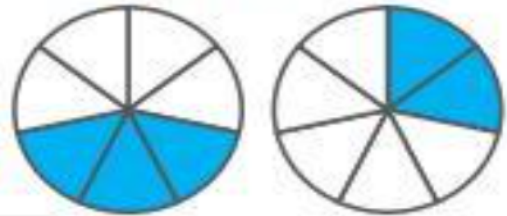
$$\frac{3}{5} + \frac{1}{5} = \frac{4}{10}$$

1b. True or false? The following calculation is correct.



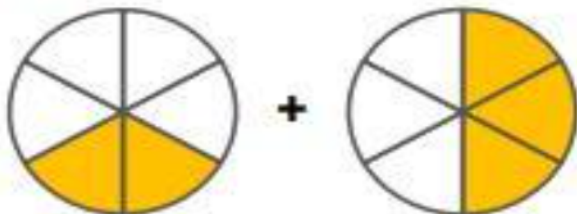
True

They have added the numerator and have not added the denominator.

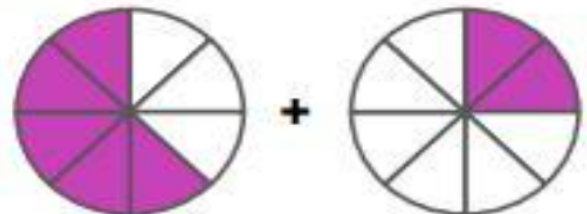
2a. Match the image to the correct answer.



A) $\frac{5}{6}$ B) $\frac{7}{6}$ C) $\frac{5}{12}$



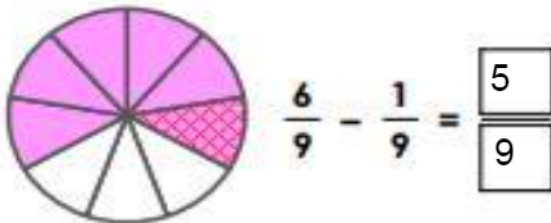
2b. Match the image to the correct answer.



A) $\frac{9}{8}$ B) $\frac{7}{8}$ C) $\frac{7}{16}$



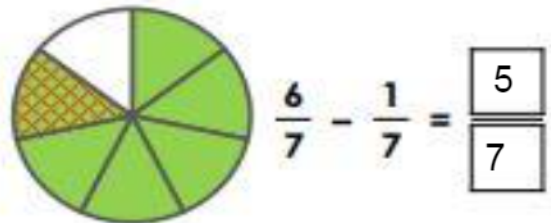
3a. Calculate the following:

$$\frac{6}{7} - \frac{1}{7} = \frac{\boxed{5}}{\boxed{7}}$$



4a. Jack drinks $\frac{3}{8}$ of his juice.

Asha drinks $\frac{4}{8}$ of her juice.

How much juice have they drunk altogether? Record your answer as a fraction.

$$\frac{3}{8} + \frac{4}{8} = \frac{7}{8}$$



4b. Sam has $\frac{6}{10}$ of a pizza.

He eats $\frac{2}{10}$ of it.

How much pizza does he have left? Record your answer as a fraction.

$$\frac{6}{10} - \frac{2}{10} = \frac{4}{10} \text{ left}$$
